

- Member of BRICS, government funding to regional partners (see chart), international involvement in aid institutions

WHY FOREIGN AID? - SOUTH AFRICA SAYS:

THE AID RATIONALE

- **Political/strategic** Instrument of domination
- Economic/commercial - Landing rights/access to ports and points of entry
- War against terrorism/drugs
- Influence in international situations
- Access to local authorities
- Friendships/neighbours

Ethical/humanitarian

- Feed and house
- Solidarity after natural disasters
- Peace, human rights and entitlements
- Export promotion
- Anti-cyclical instrument (combat recessions)
- Promotion of investments (risk mitigation)
- Access to primary products/minerals
- **Refugees/migration**
- Environmental

- Strengthened regional trade ties
- Greater international involvement

- Hopefully establishment of SADPA (aid agency within South African government) to make aid efficient
